



The Tanto International School School Fees 2008 and 2009

The Tanto International School is a private school. The education we provide for the students is financed through local council subsidies and parental fees.

The contributions from Haninge, Huddinge, Botkyrka and Tyresö (*councils) are significantly lower than the others which is why parental fees are higher if families are registered in these areas (or other low subsidy paying councils).

There are two options for payment. Either in one yearly installment or two partial installments.

The fees for the Reception/Yr1 class are different from the rest of the school. Children in this class are entitled to "Max Taxa" subsidies from the state. Parental fees are based on income. The maximum fees are around 1000 per month.

Students not registered with a Swedish personal number or who do not have EU citizenship are not necessarily entitled to the same subsidies, please contact us for more information.

Lateness fees of 300:- are charged automatically if payment has not been received by the stipulated date.

An administration charge of 300:- is charged for our waiting list. Parents must contact us by 1st September each year if they wish to stay on our waiting list. You will receive written confirmation of your request and also if a place becomes available during the year.

There is an initial registration fee of 1500:- upon enrollment to the school.

Once an offer has been made a deposit of 5000:- is required to secure it and becomes part payment towards the school fees.

Deposits are non-refundable.

If parents are planning to withdraw a student during the academic year we require 3 months notice. No refunds are given on installment payments.

If yearly payments have been made and notice has been served before 1st February we will calculate a partial refund.
