### **T.A.S.C Questionnaires**

This questionnaire is handed out each year in October. This is an excellent opportunity for us to identify areas we can improve. Information is gathered and reported back to parents. The children help us see new areas to develop and share their thoughts openly. Children and staff also meet each year to discuss guidelines and goals we have for ourselves and our friends whilst we are spending time together. This is the contract we all sign and agree-in true democratic fashion we all have a say!

### **Reviewing and Improving T.A.S.C**

All of the information gained from the parents and children (meetings, informal feedback and questionnaire results) helps us when we are reviewing our practise and setting goals to improve our TASC environment for the children. We do this during the Spring Term. Targets are set by the manager during meetings with the staff so we have all had an input in driving up standards and opportunities.
