Tanto School's Mission

- The school's mission is to encourage all pupils to discover their own uniqueness as individuals and thereby be able to participate in society by giving their best in responsible freedom.
- To achieve whatever they wish to achieve and to develop a human behaviour and responsibility that embodies the Tanto 3 C 's of Care, Co-operation and Courtesy.
- To learn and develop skills, knowledge and understanding related to curriculum and society in a fun, effective and successful way that helps children feel proud of themselves and others whilst supporting a life-long desire to learn.

T.A.S.C. is an organisation that has been set up to support the needs of our parents and children. T.A.S.C has its very own set of aims and goals which centre around those set out in the Education Act (2010:800) and the Curriculum for Compulsory Schools, Pre-School Class and Leisure-time Centres (2011-Reviderad 2016). They relate to the fundamental norms and values of Swedish schools and society.

We ensure that our pupils acquire and develop knowledge & values, and that all children have an environment that promotes a lifelong desire to learn. T.A.S.C. is a place, much the same as The Tanto International School, that establishes respect for human rights and democratic rights. We do this by learning about UNICEF Convention on Rights of a Child, which is taught throughout the school, once a week, and supported by staff, materials and the environment in TASC. This allows us to ensure we uphold the following rights:

Freedom; integrity; equal value of people; equality between genders; solidarity with the weak and vulnerable; sense of justice; generosity of spirit; tolerance and responsibility. We aim to show compassion for others; intolerance of discrimination in any form; awareness of diversity, celebration of differences and similarities as well as an empathy for others. These rights have been long since embedded in the The Tanto International School way of life. As a small school, we feel well equipped to see every individual child for who they are and who they are starting to become.

Our teachers promote these fundamental values through our interaction with children, organisation of groups as well as actively participating in democratic activities; learning about the UN Convention for the Rights of a Child and by following the Tanto 3 C's: Care, Co-operation and Courtesy.

TASC functions really well due to the fact that it requires all parties to influence and support the running of the place. Children can exercise influence on the activities as they spend time at T.A.S.C. We hope that parents feel able to influence ideas and organisation through good communication links. Feedback and positive links are essential in providing the best opportunity for each individual.

It is our aim to offer a fun and stimulating time for each child so that they can explore, socialise and develop in which ever way they need or want to, so that their own personal life is enhanced by spending time at TASC.
