Waiting List Information

When you apply for a place at the school/nursery and the classes are full your child will be placed on our waiting list. This will also happen if you request admission for a start date which lies in the future.

We accept admission throughout the year if we have places available to offer new students.

Once you have submitted the online “Application Form”, we will confirm receipt of this by sending you a confirmation letter. If we do not have a place to offer your child, he/she will be placed on the waiting list.

Your child will be placed on the waiting list according to the date the “Application Form” was submitted. However, we apply sibling priority throughout our organisation which means that siblings of students already enrolled will skip to the top of the waiting list.

For the school’s waiting list a 200 SEK fee applies. The payment details for the fee are stated in your confirmation letter and the waiting list fee does not have to be paid until you receive the confirmation letter.

Please note that if you decide not to pay the waiting list fee by the due date in the confirmation letter, your child’s place on the waiting list will be “inactive” until you pay. In case of delayed payments you will be placed on waiting list date according to payment received.

In general, we have most available places to offer for August each year. We will send out offers to children placed on our waiting list around March-May time prior to the August start. This will be done in waiting list order. If a family turns down an offered place, the place will be offered to the next child on the waiting list. If a place is made available during the rest of the year we will contact the families on the waiting list for the relevant class, in order, without delay.

We will not contact families on the waiting list until we have a place to offer.

We do not issue children on the waiting list with a “waiting list number”. This is because we feel that the numbers are “misleading” and quickly get outdated as we apply sibling priority, as well as having a truly international community where people are always in transition. This however, does not mean that we do not follow the waiting list order.

Please be aware that many other schools and nurseries require a 1-2 months notice period, or even longer on occasion. When you accept at place at our school /nursery, please make sure that you have given notice to your old institution first! Your child’s notice period will affect his/her start date with us.
